



Nukman Helwi Moeloek, born in Lampung, December 29, 1945, is a Professor of Andrology and Medical Biology from Department of Medical Biology Faculty of Medicine University of Indonesia (FMUI). Prof. Dr. dr. Nukman Helwi Moeloek, SpAnd achieved his MD from FMUI in 1971. In 1991, he received a doctorate in medical science from UI.

Prof. Dr. dr. Nukman Helwi Moeloek, SpAnd has been active in a variety of teaching experience, especially in Medical Biology, Basic Andrology, Advanced Andrology, Basic Immunology, Imuno Reproduction, Reproductive Medicine, General Biology, Cell Biology, and Embryology.
